



Policy Governing Player Safety for KLM

KLM's top priority is the safety of our players. Player Safety Guidelines are set by BC Soccer, our governing body, and align with KLM's Player Safety Policy. Player safety is accounted for both on and off the field when participating in KLM programs.

Coaching and Team Officials

All KLM staff coaches and coaching officials must provide a clean and up to date criminal record check including the vulnerable sector component prior to engaging in any coaching matters.
